Dear Parents and Carers,

In this letter, we explain how pupils can log into their Google Classroom portal at home and how we would like you to use Google Classroom to complement pupils' in-school learning when at home.

In recent weeks, at Plumpton Primary School, we have been working hard to ensure that our pupils and staff are safe *on-site*. However, we are also mindful that we may still be required to offer remote learning with little or no notice if we find ourselves subject to a localised or national lockdown.

To this end, as explained in last week's Newsletter, we have been working hard to prepare our remote learning offer using **Google Classroom**. The children have been given opportunities to log into this portal during lesson time and have been completing tasks, such as quizzes, using the platform.

Today, all pupils will come home with their Google Classroom log-in details. They will be attached to the front page of their Reading Record (alongside their Times Tables Rockstars/Numbots log-in) and will also be attached to a hard copy of this letter.

On Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> October – at the end of this week – we encourage you to log into the platform to find your child's first piece of homework set on G-suite. We have moved our homework from our blogs to this platform, in order to allow children, parents and staff additional opportunities to practise using the platform.
