As explained in our letter last week regarding the beginning of the new academic year, we will soon be sharing with pupils, and their parents, **G-suite** log-ins which can be accessed should the school be in a position in which a localised lockdown has been imposed.

In order for pupils and families to become proficient in using Google Classrooms and G-Suite, we will move our Home Learning tasks to this platform in the coming weeks. Instead of sending children home with homework books, we will set homework tasks via this online platform. This should help develop confidence in using the software should it need to be used for online lessons in the future.

Until this infrastructure is fully set up in a few weeks' time, we ask that parents and carers do the following at home to complement what is being taught at school for the time being:

- Reading, and making a note of this in your child's Reading Record;
- Times Tables Rockstars practice (if in Year 3 and above);
- Some home learning tasks relating to our topic of Take One Treasure found, for now, on the class blogs.
