

English-

We will begin the year by studying a book called Ruby's Worry where the children will be exploring their own feelings, developing their vocabulary and retelling the story in their own words. We will then use two books related to our project work (Lila and the Secret of the Rain and The Toy Museum) as a basis for developing writing skills, focusing in particular on punctuation, vocabulary and adding detail to our sentences. The children will also have the opportunity to use drama to explore the stories and characters.

'Daily phonics lessons will continue in Year One and Year two groupings. Please make sure you are reading daily at home.

<u>Maths</u>—

This term we will begin with a focus on Number and Place Value. Ensuring the children are confident with their counting forwards, and backwards as well as in 2's, 5's and 10's. Children will be sorting, representing and comparing groups of objects and numbers and identifying one or ten more and one or 10 less than given numbers.

We will then move onto applying our understanding of number and place value to addition and subtraction.

<u>Science</u>-

Throughout the year we shall be observing changes across the 4 seasons. This term we shall we focusing on Autumn. This will involve us using our wonderful environment looking for signs that Autumn is here.

We will also be learning about animals including humans. The children will identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

<u>PE-</u> This term Lapwings will be have their PE sessions on a Monday and Thursday. The focus this term is Coordination and team games. In Term 2 the focus will be dance. Please come to school on Mondays and Thursdays in your PE kits.



PSHE- This term's focus is 'Being Me in My World' We will be identifying some of our hopes and fears for the year.

We will understand the rights and responsibilities of being a member of Lapwings and Plumpton School and what to do if we are worried.

<u>Computing</u>—We will be using a programme called Purple Mash to hone the children's understanding of coding, and to improve their articulacy of key points relating to e-safety.

<u>Art and DT</u> — Children will continue to produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences. We will continue to develop our drawing,

<u>History</u>—

Our History work in Term 1 and 2 is especially important as the focus of our Discover project.

The focus of Term 1 will be families and we will begin to explore simple timelines and family trees. We will be thinking about what life was like for our Ancestors compared to our experiences now. We will also analyse and compare photographs from the past and present. We will be comparing toys from the past and toys we play with now, and we are hoping to have a visit from a Toy Museum!

Then, in Term 2 we will be learning about three important woman from history: Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Emily Davison. We will be placing them on a timeline and comparing photographs of them with photographs of our own family. We will be learning about the kindness that these woman showed and how they made a difference to others.

Music – In Term 1 we will be learning harvest songs in preparation for our Harvest celebration. In Term 2 we will begin preparing for our Nativity performance.

RE - During term one, we will be looking at the religion of Islam and exploring what Muslims believe and how this makes a difference to how they live. The children will learn about Muslims belief in Allah as the one true God and we will learn the words to the Shahadah. We will also explore stories of the prophet Muhammed and think about how these stories inspire people today. As December approaches, we will begin to study the Christian Nativity story as we prepare for the popular KS1 Nativity performance.

Please listen to your children read at home as often as possible. We recommend at least 4 times a week,. In addition to reading aloud to you, reading to your child every day is so helpful in developing their reading skills, and overall love of reading.


