### **ENGLISH**

We will begin our English lessons this term using the text 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs' By A. Wolf (As told to Jon Scieszka!) We will be exploring the text through drama and will be learning about time and place adverbials, conjunctions and onomatopoeia.

### **ART**

We will be focussing on Landscape art over the next two terms. We will be exploring a variety of art techniques and materials. David Hockney and Van Gogh are the artists that we will be especially focussing on. As well as developing our own artistic skills we will also be learning how to analyse pieces of artwork. We will be recording our creative journey in our own sketch books as well as creating some final pieces for an art exhibition.



### **SCIENCE**

This term, we will be making the most of the sunshine and our fabulous outside area to learn all about plants. Woodpeckers will be learning the names of different parts of plants, and the jobs they do. We will be working scientifically and collaboratively to investigate what plants need to grow well. Furthermore, the children will have chance to predict what will happen in an exciting investigation into the transportation of water within plants. They will work in a hands-on way to identify the parts of a flower and will explore the different stages of the life cycle of a flowering plant.

### **FRENCH**

In French, we will be continuing to learn how to count, say the days of the week and months of the year.

We shall also be learning the names of common animals and foods.


### **MATHS**

Our main focus at the beginning of Term 5 will be fractions. We will then move onto Multiplication and Division, before returning to further consolidate addition and subtraction. We will be guided in our planning by the 'Ready-to-progress' criteria document that has been produced as a result of national school closures to help ensure all children are confident in the key mathematical objectives required for their year group.

### **MUSIC**

We will be learning to use specific musical terms, for example rhythm, beat, tempo and dynamics. We will be using these terms when analysing pieces of music, we will learn to listen out for particular instruments playing and will evaluate musical pieces, talking about how music can affect our mood as well as discussing likes and dislikes.

In our sessions with Mrs Farey, we will be composing our own piece of music using our own body percussion – which we hope to perform.

<u>PE</u>

This term PE will be on a Monday. Our focus is Rounders. We will be honing our batting, bowling and fielding skills as well as playing the game in teams.



# **COMPUTING**

In computing we will be researching artists and creating collages. We will also be continuing to learn to touch type and will be exploring further coding activities.
