Our learning this term

This term our rocking Robins are learning about 'Growing' and will track the progress of seeds and plants as they grow throughout the Spring months. They will be reading **Bog Baby**. Our wonderful Woodpeckers will be learning about Castles (I wish I could go back to Year 1/2!) and will read a book called The Paper Bag Princess – a parody of the traditional Dragon-Princess relationship. Kingfishers are learning about their 'Local Environment' this term, capped off with an exciting trip to Cuckmere Haven, and will read my favourite lower Key Stage 2 text: *Oliver and the* Seawigs. It follows a young boy's journey to save his parents from the wrath of a 'rambling isle' called Thurlstone (and his sidekick Stacey de Lacey). Finally, Owls are also learning about Local Geography and are reading a text called *The Viewer*; it is all about a young boy's discovery of an old viewer which takes him on a journey of discovery and opens his eyes to the past and future of humanity.
