- -Robins Class Children will be dismissed at 3pm from the outside gate: this is an amendment to the time discussed at the meeting. We are sorry about this. We have made this change to help ease congestion at the end of the day and to keep children and families as safe as possible.
- -PE will start on Mondays from 5th October; please wear a PE kit to school as discussed.
- -Forest School will start on Fridays from 2nd October. Please provide waterproofs and wellies for this effective from your child's first settling session (as we also use these in school).
- -An additional healthy snack can be provided in a named box; however, **this must not contain nuts.** A named and filled water bottle should be provided also.
- -Lunch choices will be ordered with your child before school and written next to your child's name on the list outside each day. Each morning, please remember to enter your child's lunch choice on this list.
- -Tapestry accounts are being linked to your emails, please look for an activation email in your inbox this week. Please do take a photo of something you do together in the next few weeks which your child can share with their friends.
- -When Forest School begins, children should wear comfortable clothes to school on Fridays to go underneath waterproofs rather than uniform. Please put spare clothes in the forest school bag to stay on their peg.
