Welcome back! We hope you have all had a lovely, restful holiday. The children all arrived bright eyed and enthusiastic on Monday morning and ready for an exciting summer term ahead.

New Topics

This term, the children in KS1 will be learning about 'Bugs and Plants'. Robin class will be studying the life cycle of the butterfly and reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle. They will also be planting seeds and learning how to care for plants. This focus will include reading 'Jack and the Beanstalk' – I wonder if any of their seeds will grow as big as Jack's did?



Meanwhile, Woodpecker class will be studying plants and learning how to identify different species. They will also learn about the best growing conditions that plants need, while developing their knowledge through the beautiful picture story book 'Bog Baby' by Jeanne Willis. In Geography, the children will learn about field work and identification skills.



The children in KS2 will be travelling back in time to learn about the Ancient Maya Civilisation. The journey will begin 4,000 years ago and end with the arrival of the Spanish in 1517AD.

Kingfisher class will be studying 'Journey to the River Sea' by Eva Ibbotson, which details the journey of young Maia from London to the Amazon Rainforest. While in Owl class, the children will study ancient Mayan myths and folk tales including 'The Hero Twins'.


