### Reading



## Mathematical Development

We continue to develop our understanding of Maths through practical activities, games and the children's play.

Continued recognition of 10-20, ordering and counting carefully. Thinking about more/less and finding numbers on the number line. Adding and taking away through practical activities and games. Beginning to record their own maths problems. Counting in 2's 5's 10's and sharing into equal groups.

Capacity and volume through play with sand and water. Measuring our plants and comparing using length vocabulary. Making models, and finding 2D and 3D shapes in the environment and using shape language. Talking about time!

# Language and Literacy

We have had a super start to our topic through 'Were Going on a Bear Hunt!' We have had so much fun this week retelling the story, using the instruments to match the scenes, making puppets and painting pictures.

Next week we will move onto The Magic Paintbrush with a focus on Chinese customs, Chinese writing, sentences about what magic we would create with our own Magic Paintbrush and writing speech bubbles. We finish the term with The Billy Goats, it will be so much fun to retell the story and write character descriptions

In Term 6 we will link to our focus on growing through reading 'The Tiny Seed' and writing about what plants need to grow. We then use our senses to explore the jungle through 'Walking Through the Jungle' and imagine we are walking through different landscapes. We then look at the beautifully illustrated text 'The Fox and the Star,' find out some information about foxes and write a lost poster for our star!

Through all of our texts we will be using our phonic knowledge to hear and write the sounds in short words to create a sentence.

## Phonics

We are nearly at the end of phase 3 focussed on diagraphs and trigraphs (2 and 3 letters which make one sound).

We now need to practise using these through reading and writing games and writing for a purpose in play and linked to our core texts.

In addition to the phonics our focus will be supporting all of the children to write sentences as often as possible to develop confidence and skills. Keep practising those keywords at home!

## Physical Development

In P.E. we will focus on ball skills and games in preparation for Sports Day!

We continue to strengthen hand muscles through dough, cutting, drawing, painting, threading and other fine motor activities. **Please do support these activities at home too!** 

We will strengthen our shoulder and arm muscles for writing through big drawing, use of brushes and rollers outside and hanging and swinging in the school park.

# Our Project is... I Can Create!

We are very excited about our new topic which includes some texts with wonderful illustrations linked to famous paintings and pieces of music.

The children will be able to use media and materials in lots of different ways, learning how artists and musicians work and using these skills in their own explorations.

We will also take advantage of the Spring to find out about plant growth first hand and learn more about the caterpillar life cycle!

In addition we will be thinking about different cultures and customs linked to the text 'The Magic Paintbrush' which helps the children to understand different ways of life.

## Understanding of the World

Through our focus on China and Chinese customs we will talk about similarities and differences between cultures.

In addition to planting and growing lots of seeds we will adopt some caterpillars and watch them grow and change, linked to 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar.' We will find out caterpillar facts and learn about their lifecycle.

We will use the iPads to record our Billy Goat's Gruff role play and watch it back with our friends.

## Expressive Art and Design

Through our topic 'I Can Create' we will look at many beautiful artworks including Willow Pattern art, Monet's bridge and Van Gogh's Sunflower Field.

We will compose our own soundscapes to accompany our stories and explore movement linked to Bear Hunt and Walking Through the Jungle.

We will retell and act out Bear Hunt and Billy Goats using language from the story, explore the characters and work with our friends to 'put on a show!'

We will make a giant cave, bridges and a clay fox to link with our texts.
